2018-19 Achievements part 2

- 4. Establishment of Ellerslie Songbird Project OLB grant
 - ► Trapping rats to enable native birds to thrive
 - ► Highly successful in eastern suburbs, strong takeup here too
 - Support also gratefully received from <u>Ellerslie Business Association</u> and <u>Barfoot & Thompson</u> <u>Ellerslie</u>
- 5. Improved lighting on Hewson/Findlay walkway by the train station OLB/EBA
 - ► Longer arms on lights mean much less shading by the hedge → improved safety
 - Proposed widening of the footpath approved by AT, construction pending
- 6. Worked with Living Streets (Council agency) on footpath upgrade project
 - Improved communication with residents
- 7. Allied Concrete overnight noise issue addressed
- 8. Strong working relationship with EBA
 - Particularly regard to the AT Parking Consultation





Projects for 2019-20

- 1. Continue to work closely with Ōrākei Local Board on issues such as traffic safety
 - Particularly pedestrian safety and intersection improvements
 - Relocating the Ladies Mile cycle lane to a better location
 - Opening the Ballarat St paper road to pedestrians and cyclists
- 2. Ongoing working relationship with the Ellerslie Business Association
- 3. Expand the Ellerslie Songbird Project
- 4. Michaels Avenue Reserve
 - ► Continued engagement with OLB and sports clubs
 - 1. Clubhouse project
 - 2. Path lighting improvements
 - 3. Tree planting
- 5. Continue to work with Living Streets and other Council agencies
- 6. Revamp and update ERA Constitution and website


Ellerslie Cycleway Concept


