

## 2020-21 Achievements part 1

- 1. Michaels Ave Reserve pathway lighting
  - Massive safety and amenity improvement!
    - From a handful of working lights to over 40
  - Also some footpath repairs and two new park benches





#### 2020-21 Achievements part 2

- E-waste collection event OLB grant
  - Initially Saturday 31 October 2020, rescheduled to Saturday 17 April 2021
    - Due to Council inorganic collection and COVID-19
  - Residents of Ellerslie can drop off (normally charged) items for free!
  - 16,163kg of e-waste, over 900 items dropped off by 300 people
- Public meeting 5 October 2020 for general election Maungakiekie candidates
- Promoting discussion and resident engagement in various Council/AT consultations
  - Ten-Year Budget, Regional Land Transport Plan, Lunn Ave pedestrian shelters...
- Strong working relationship with EBA
  - ERA attendance at EBA meetings, Neighbours Day 20 March 2021
- Ellerslie Songbird Project OLB grant
  - Trapping rats to enable native birds to thrive
  - Highly successful in eastern suburbs, strong takeup here too
  - Support also gratefully received from Ellerslie Business Association and Barfoot & Inompson Ellers
- Worked with Living Streets (Council agency) on footpath upgrade projects
  - Improved communication with residents
- ERA website relaunched, Rules revamped

### Projects for July 2021-June 2022

- 1. Continue to work closely with Ōrākei Local Board on issues such as traffic safety
  - Particularly pedestrian safety and intersection improvements
    - ▶ Auckland Transport is moving ahead with traffic lights at Ladies Mile/Pukerangi Cres./Morrin St.
  - Relocating the Ladies Mile cycle lane to a better location
  - Opening the Ballarat St paper road to pedestrians and cyclists
  - More pedestrian crossings in appropriate locations
- 2. Ongoing working relationship with the Ellerslie Business Association
- 3. Second e-waste collection event
  - Held on Saturday March 12 thanks to OLB grant
- 4. Michaels Avenue Reserve
  - Continued engagement with OLB and sports clubs
    - 1. Clubhouse project construction started mid-2021
    - 2. ERA Chair Glen helping with comms at <a href="mailto:facebook.com/MichaelsAvenuePavilion">facebook.com/MichaelsAvenuePavilion</a>
    - 3. Tree planting
    - 4. Reserve Liaison committee helping sports clubs, Council etc. see issues from resident perspective
- 5. Continue to work with Living Streets and other Council agencies about resident concerns
  - ▶ E.g. Eaglehurst Rd./Gavin St. area smell and trucks
- 6. Revamp and update ERA website
- 7. And to work on your big ideas!


# Ellerslie Cycleway Concept

North-south connection for school students, leisure, commuting (train station

access, on to Tamaki Drive)

 Relocate Ladies Mile cycle lane, create a safe, separated cycleway on Amy St/Arron St...

- Reopen Gavin St-McNab St connection
  - Address motorway severance
  - Provide choice of getting to work in Penrose
  - Access from Gavin St carpark/residential areato Penrose Station



## Ellerslie Community Centre Concept

- The need for a community hub for school students, new parents... continues to grow
- Ellerslie town centre has great commercial facilities but lacks quality public facilities
  - Community centre, kid's playground...
- Potential for tie-in with the refurbishment of War Memorial Hall
- Potential for PPP funding and/or partnership with Kāinga Ora (Housing NZ)
- ▶ Ōrākei Local Board is actively working to make this concept a reality ☺
